SCHOOL RULES AND REGULATIONS



1. CHRISTIAN FOUNDATION

GOFISHNET HAPPY KIDS ACADEMY is founded on Christian values and Biblical principles.

The school upholds:

- Respect for God
- Integrity
- Honesty
- Obedience
- Moral uprightness

Learners are expected to:

1. Participate in school prayers, devotions, and Christian activities.
2. Demonstrate Christ-like behavior at all times.
3. Avoid immoral conduct, abusive speech, and disrespectful actions.
4. Uphold righteousness both inside and outside the school.

The fear of God is the beginning of wisdom, and all learners must reflect godly character.

2. GENERAL DISCIPLINE

1. Discipline must be observed at all times.
2. Respect must be accorded to:
 - School sponsors
 - Headteacher and Deputies
 - Teachers and staff
 - School offices and leadership
 - Fellow learners
3. Disrespect, arrogance, defiance, or insubordination will attract serious disciplinary action.
4. Fighting, bullying, threatening, or abusive language is strictly forbidden.
5. Stealing, lying, cheating, or vandalism will not be tolerated.
6. Public display of misconduct or immoral behavior is prohibited.



7. Every learner must uphold the school motto: **Excel to the Highest** in conduct and academics.

3. LANGUAGE POLICY (STRICTLY ENFORCED)

1. The only recognized languages within the school compound are:
 - English
 - Kiswahili
2. Communication in any other language is strictly prohibited.
3. Violation of this rule will attract punishment including:
 - Written warning
 - Extra academic work
 - Purchase of recommended novels or books to improve language proficiency
4. Repeated violation will result in parent involvement and further disciplinary measures.

4. ATTENDANCE AND PUNCTUALITY

1. All learners must report to school on time daily.
2. Late coming without valid written explanation will attract corrective action.
3. Absenteeism without communication is unacceptable.
4. Leaving school without permission is a serious offense.
5. Attendance in assemblies, lessons, devotions, and co-curricular activities is compulsory.

5. SCHOOL UNIFORM AND GROOMING

1. Full and proper school uniform must be worn at all times.
2. Only **polishable black shoes** are recognized.
3. Shoes must be clean and polished daily.
4. Hair must be neat, simple, and appropriate.
5. No fancy hairstyles, shaved patterns, or coloring allowed.
6. Jewelry, nail polish, makeup, and unauthorized accessories are prohibited.
7. Untidy appearance will attract corrective measures.

6. ACADEMIC RESPONSIBILITY

1. All learners must take academic work seriously.
2. Homework must be completed and submitted on time.

3. Cheating in exams or assignments is a serious offense.
4. CBC projects must be done honestly.
5. Academic negligence will not be tolerated.
6. Continuous poor performance due to indiscipline will lead to intervention.

7. RESPECT FOR SPONSORS AND SCHOOL AUTHORITY

1. The school is fully sponsored; gratitude and respect must be shown at all times.
2. Any disrespect, defamation, or negative speech against sponsors or administration will attract disciplinary action.
3. All school offices must be respected.
4. Instructions from teachers and administration must be obeyed immediately and without argument.

8. PROHIBITED ITEMS

The following are strictly forbidden:

- Mobile phones
- Electronic gadgets
- Weapons or sharp objects
- Drugs or harmful substances
- Pornographic or immoral materials
- Unauthorized reading materials

Confiscated items will only be released to parents, and further action may be taken.

9. SCHOOL PROPERTY

1. School property must be handled with care.
2. Writing on walls, desks, toilets, or furniture is prohibited.
3. Any damage must be paid for by the parent/guardian.
4. Books must be covered and well-maintained.

10. DISCIPLINARY MEASURES

Discipline at GOFISHNET HAPPY KIDS ACADEMY is firm, corrective, and progressive.

Depending on the offense, the following may apply:

- Verbal warning
- Written warning
- Extra duties
- Academic corrective measures
- Purchase of educational materials
- Parent/guardian conference
- Suspension
- Expulsion (in extreme cases)

The decision of the school administration is final.
